(Food Technology & Management) programme of National Institute of Food Technology Entrepreneurship and Management (NIFTEM), Kundli for the academic year 2020-2021 through JoSAA/CSAB- 2020 are requested to report in online mode as per the schedule given below.

- 13. Due to the Covid-19 pandemic, If any student unable to get the EWS/OBC-NCL certificate issued by the Competent Authority then he/she can submit an affidavit which is available on the NIFTEM admission site.
