The exam server will be made accessible from 8:00 AM on both exam days. Your login & password SHALL NOT work when the exam server is OFF.

Same login credentials shall work on 17th & 18th September for all the candidates.

Candidates must ensure they are attempting the same paper which they have opted in the application form. In case of any concern, please get this corrected/clarified till the end of day 17th Sep. No such requests shall be addressed on the day of final exam (18th Sep) & attempting any other paper will lead to disqualification.

Exam can either be taken on Android Mobile Phone by downloading a mobile app from the URL mentioned below (see instructions for mobile app) or directly from the Chrome Browser on your Windows Laptop/Desktop. No app is required for exam to be taken from the Chrome Browser.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR BROWSER ACCESS

Type the URL https://niftem.icalibrator.com in your chrome browser. The Chrome is the preferred browser. In the login page which is displayed enter your **LOGIN ID** & **PASSWORD**.

Click on the Login button. It will ask you permission for taking video and audio, please give these permissions; otherwise you will not be able to continue with the exam.

Ensure Google Chrome on your Laptop/Desktop has been pre-configured to allow Camera & Microphone permissions. If not done already, pls follow as below Open Chrome.

At the top right, click more. Settings.

Under "Privacy and security," click Site settings.

Click Camera or Microphone. Turn on or Ask before accessing. Review your blocked and allowed sites.

https://niftem.icalibrator.com should be your allowed site.

Ensure your Laptop/Desktop Date is correct & Time is set at (UTC+05:30) Chennai, Kolkata, Mumbai, New Delhi

Ensure your Browser Cache is cleaned. If not done already, pls follow as below Open Chrome.

At the top right, click more. Click More Tools, Clear Browsing Data

Select all time, Next to "Cookies & other site data" and "Cached images & files"" check the boxes. Click Clear Data.

After successful login, you will be shown the exam info (Course/Paper) that you have to take. If you login early, it will show when it is expected to start. The start Button will show up when stipulated time arrives. Click on the Start Button. It will show you the following instructions. Continue and take the test.

INSTRUCTIONS ABOUT QUESTIONS

- The questions will be displayed one question at a time.
- Next and Previous buttons will take you to the next or previous question.
- The time remaining will be shown at the top of the page and will be updated every second.
- Clicking the Submit button shall submit all your answers and end the session. Once submitted, you will not be able to re-attempt the exercise.
- Each multiple-choice question has only one correct answer which should be selected for full marks.
- There may be some text questions where you are required to fill in answers using your keypad/keyboard.
- In match-the-following questions, you need to use the Up button to move the choices on the right up to rearrange them and place the right choices in front of the ones given on the left.



ENSURE android mobile app version should be displayed as ver 3.29 (at the log-in screen)



When you start the application for the first time it will ask you to allow display over other apps, please enable this option. It will also ask you permission for taking video and audio, please give these permissions. Otherwise you will not be able to continue with the exam.

- For Candidates attempting exam from outside INDIA, they can take it from Chrome Browser on laptop/Desktop. App will not be available outside India
- Exam Syllabus has already been uploaded on NIFTEM website, department wise. RET syllabus and interview scheme of exam has already been mentioned in the admission brochure 2020-21 (page 38).
- Once logged in, logging out or switching to another application or browser tab or accepting incoming calls or moving out of the exam screen for any reason shall submit your exam
- Once an exam is submitted by clicking on submit button, you will not be allowed to login again. So press SUBMIT once you are through & sure to submit your exam.
- You can come back to previous questions & change your response multiple times during the exam time.
- You can use the question navigator to go to any question out of sequence. In the App, you can click on the question navigator button and choose the question, in the browser it is always visible on the right most panel.
- The QUESTION NAVIGATOR dashboard colors, GREEN Question attempted; YELLOW: SEEN not attempted; ORANGE: attempted but you wish to review it later. If you have submitted your answers with ORANGE options (means you wished to change/review your answer option (already attempted) if time would have permitted but didn't get time to change the earlier marked option), it shall be treated as GREEN marked & attempted.
